Requirements

Track I **Venture Discovery**

Venture Discovery requires an F1 visa and 12 academic units with at least 8 units of SCET coursework.

Track II **Venture Validation**

Venture Validation requires a J1 visa and 9 academic units with at least 7 units of SCET coursework. Students must be sponsored.
